Register NOW for Spring Youth Programs

Youth classes start at the end of January. Registration forms are available in the Welcome Room. You must register by January 15th

Spiritual Education Experience (S.E.E.): Educational program for children from 4-years old through 5th grade on Wednesday nights from 6:00 to 7:00 p.m. Students break up by grade, and then Bible stories are taught to the children in a fun, learning environment through games, skits, songs, and fellowship.

Holy Communion: Six-week class offered in the spring for children in grades 2 and up. Children learn about Communion and the Lord’s Supper – why we do it, what it means, and how we do it. Classes take place during S.E.E.

RISEN: Cross of Glory is a place where everyone is welcome. That includes people with special needs. **RISEN** is a 60 minute educational/social experience. The hour is conducted through a structural format using a visual schedule. In addition, **RISEN** is supported by individuals with experience in special education with both youth and adults. During the hour session we strive to have a designated buddy/volunteer for each participant. **RISEN** runs alongside S.E.E.

Teen Education for Lifelong Leadership (T.E.L.L.)/Confirmation: Educational program for youth from 6th through 12th grade on Monday nights from 6:30 to 8:00 p.m. 6th graders have their own special class where they learn about faith and do projects together. 7th and 8th graders participate in our **Confirmation Class** which covers the basics of the Bible and of our faith tradition. It is designed to help our youth own their faith for themselves. Our high school teens spend time interacting with each other to experience God through games, food, and conversation.
