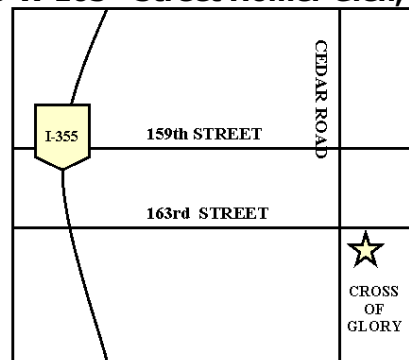

NOISY OFFERING

Our April noisy offering went to Centro Infantil (fka Casa de los Angeles), our longstanding partner and the beneficiary of our Mexican fundraiser on May 4th. We raised \$500 in April for the benefit of Centro Infantil. Way to go Cross of Glory!!!

Our noisy offering in May will go to HALO, a homeless shelter in Racine, which I was involved with when I was a pastor up there. HALO is the primary/only homeless shelter in Racine and works with the community's very large homeless population. (Racine's economy has been struggling for some time as a result of the loss of some big industrial employers.) HALO has been operating at or over capacity for the past 10 months, each month experiencing a shortfall of \$25,000. The building was meant to accommodate 60 men and 60 women and children, but it currently houses 100 men each night, which means that many are sleeping on mats on the dining area floors. (The women's section is also full.) I know what giving hearts we have here at COG, and I'm hoping we can help out the people in that community. Please save your change (and paper money works well too) for our noisy offering on Sunday, May 13th

I want to thank all of you for the way you have so quickly embraced our partnership with Fairmont School in Lockport. We just started this partnership before Christmas, and already we have collected school supplies, personal care items, and lots and lots of books, provided some families with Christmas gifts, and volunteered at two school-wide events. And that's on top of the eight to ten people (and one dog) who go to Fairmont regularly to help in the classrooms and library, to read to kids, to organize rooms, and to work with parents on their English skills. We have heard nothing but wonderful comments from the kids and staff at Fairmont, and hope to expand our partnership next fall, both in terms of what we do and how many are involved. We will also be doing more to connect with the families in the Fairmont community over the summer through our mobile free little library and other events.

And during May I hope to have one more visit to the teachers at Fairmont to thank them for the work they've put in all year with the kids and families. Look for more on that thank-you visit in the next few weeks. For right now, however, I want to make sure you all know how awesome you all are.
